

Suggested Packing List for HOBY Los Angeles 2018

- Bedding Participants will need to provide their own bedding supplies (pillows, bedsheets, sleeping bag, etc.)
- Bath Towels Participants will need to provide their own bath towels.
- **Toiletries** shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, personal care products.
- Hair dryer
- Clothing
 - Casual, comfortable clothing shirts, shorts, jeans/long pants, etc.
 - A seminar t-shirt will be provided at check in to be worn Friday and Saturday.
 - Jacket, sweatshirt or other long sleeve shirts.
 - o Dress attire for Sunday:
 - Ladies skirts, dresses or dress pants.
 - Men dress pants and shirt.
- Sturdy walking shoes
- Alarm clock
- Small fan (optional)
- Small amount of spending money (optional for HOBY merchandise and other items available during the weekend)
- Camera
- Water bottle
- Any completed pre-seminar forms or room key deposit checks that were not previously returned to us by mail (applies only to late registrants)
- OTC Medication as needed

Community Service Donation Items: We will be conducting Leadership for Service projects in conjunction with community service partner organizations at the seminar. Items will be collected during check-in at the seminar.

- Hygiene Packs for the Covenant Homeless Youth Shelter

- Project Linus: Handmade fleece blankets for critically ill children.
 - 1.5 yard pieces of polar fleece.
 - Scissors.
